## Creating Safe and Secure Passwords

It is important to make your passwords are as strong as possible. Here are some tips to make sure your information is secured with strong, manageable passwords:

1. Don't use just one password. Each account that you have should have its own, unique password.
2. Include numbers, symbols and capital letters. Consider replacing letters with symbols to make it harder to crack.
3. Quantity can be just as good as quality. The more digits in a password, the harder it is to figure out. Try making your passwords with a minimum of 12 characters.
4. Using unique passwords, avoiding phishing sites, and keeping your computer safe from password-capturing malware is also important. Yes, you should choose a strong password — but you need to do more than that. Using stronger passwords won't keep you secure from *all* the threats out there, but it's a good first step!
